Missions Update

Last week Team Uganda gave a report about their trip. While there, they worked with Abdu and Betty. Lindsay Tarver wrote the segment below; please take time to read, pray and consider how you can be a part in changing the lives of the fatherless children in Uganda.

Abdu and Betty have started a preschool in a small village just outside of Jinja. The women in this village have no resources, no skills, and they rely on prostitution to support themselves. Many of these women have had children as a result of their prostitution, and of course the fathers are unknown to the women.

The vision of this preschool is for these children to realize that they are just as important in the kingdom of God as any other man, woman, or child. These children may not have an earthly father, but they have a heavenly Father who loves and cares for them. Betty and Abdu are showing these children the love of Jesus and they are bringing hope to them at a young age. The hope is to end this cycle. Betty is working to build relationships, not only with these children, but with their mothers and families as well. She is showing the love of Jesus to a village that has been forgotten, left behind, and full of hopelessness. She is changing a nation, and I am so excited to partner with her and her family on this endeavor.

Abdu and Betty are working to save \$5,000.00 to buy land to build a permanent preschool. They are currently renting a building, and they pay a substantial amount every month to keep the preschool running. We asked how they pay the rent and the teachers as the children aren't turned away when they are not able to pay their school fees. Betty, who is a very humble woman, replied that they pay the expenses out of their own pockets. These are people who have very little of their own but are committed to this ministry and ensuring that it continues.
