Jerry Bosevanua is one of our missionaries in India and has been in Fiji for the last couple months visiting family, staffing with us, and preparing to go to Brazil in a month to get married. He had come back to Fiji because he had contracted Tuberculosis while in India. It is a horrible sickness and he was told that he would have to be on medication for who knows how long. He had gone to the Doctor two weeks earlier and was told that the medication was not working and things were not progressing the way they should. It was looking bad for him.

We made this a matter of prayer and prayed earnestly for a miracle. As a result of our prayers, when he went to the Doctor in Suva last week, he was told him that he was completely well and considered cured. They gave him a clean bill of health!!!
